Dear Santa Fe Public Schools Parent,

Santa Fe Public Schools has begun the process of adopting instructional materials in the content areas of English Language Arts, Spanish Language Arts, English Language Development, and World Languages Adoption for the 2021-2022 school year. Committees have been formed with representatives from stakeholders throughout the County of Santa Fe. SFPS teachers, administrators, parents and community members will meet regularly to review above referenced materials and make recommendations for adoption. The materials will be purchased as part of the State's six-year adoption cycle established by the New Mexico Public Education Department (NMPED).

According to SFPS Board Policy, families are to be notified of the instructional materials process. Additionally, Board Policy states that the district is to notify the parent, guardian or student of their responsibility for any loss, damage or destruction of instructional materials while in the possession of the student.

Of paramount interest to SFPS is the well-being of our students. We are excited to have the opportunity to provide our students and teachers with updated instructional materials.
